

SEASON 18 CLASS EXPECTATIONS

Classes with Miss Sam

Hi! Welcome to Miss Sam's classes. Below you will find the expectations that are to be followed every week in the class.

- 1. Dancers are expected to be on time.
- 2. When entering, bring your water bottle, socks, and pants (on days specified).
- 3. Miss Sam would prefer dancers not wear apple watches or fit bits in class. If it becomes too much of a distraction, you will be asked to put it away.
- 4. At the beginning of class while Miss Sam is taking roll, dancers are expected to be sitting in their straddle position, stretching and not talking to other dancer in the room.
- 5. Restroom breaks are expected to be taken before and after class only.
- 6. Dancers are expected to come into class ready to learn, not bringing outside problems into the room.
- 7. Dancers are expected to keep an open mind in these classes.
- 8. When a situation or issues arise, dancers are expected to inform Miss Sam immediately.
- 9. Dancers are to raise their hand when asking a question and wait to be called on. Do not call out at Miss Sam, she will ignore you.
- 10. Dancers are never allowed to sit in class unless instructed to do so.
- 11. Dancers are not allowed to lean against the wall or barres.
- 12. When going across the floor or in groups, dancers are expected to observe each other. This is one of the best forms of learning and making yourself better not only as a person but as a dancer as well.

- 13. Dancers are not to be twirling or moving when Miss Sam is talking and giving corrections.
- 14. Absolutely no cartwheels in class!
- 15. When the music turns off, Miss Sam expects all dancers to stop, turn to her and listen for instruction.
- 16. When you hear Miss Sam's voice, you stop talking.
- 17. Dancers are expected to be 100% engaged and involved in all things that are happening in class.
- 18. Dancer are to be supportive of on another. THIS IS A JUDGEMENT FREE ZONE!
- 19. There is NO TOLERANCE for bullying in Miss Sam's classes and will get no warning, instead just asked not to return to class.
- 20. Overall, dancers are expected to come to class with a good attitude and be ready to learn and work hard.

Following these rules will ensure safe and progressive class space for the students. Failure to follow these rules will result in student(s) not being able to participate in certain activities/class for the day or being sent to the front desk.
